Summarised Notes on Procedure in Completing Part 2

- Step 1 From previous F.Y.'s L.U.R., bring forward finalised figures at the end of that F.Y., entering these in column headed "B/F as at 30/9/?". Repeat for Acquired and Afforested, as appropriate.
- Step 2 After planting is completed, or at end of Forest Year under revision, enter current figures for new stockings, destockings, i.e. in sections 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7 (starred items) and in centre columns headed "add curnt Figs F.Y. ?".
Again repeat for Acquired and Afforested.
- Step 3 Cross total adding current to previous figures to find Final Position i.e. in 3rd column headed "Position as at 30/9/?".
- Step 4 In the case of Sections 2 and 3, check that the totals of the a^s to the d^s also tally.
- Step 5 Using appropriate mask, find the Replantable Balances in Section 4 by subtracting 3a from 2a to find 4a, 3b from 2b to find 4b and so on, finishing with 3 from 2 to find the total 4. This can be done first with 'Current' and then with 'Position at end of F.Y. columns' - and again both for Acquired and Afforested.
- Step 6 As a check, withdraw mask and see that the cross totalling of the Section 4 series tallies.
- Step 7 Add Sections 4, 5, 6, and 7 to find 8 and check cross totalling - for Acquired and Afforested as appropriate.
- Step 8 Using appropriate mask, subtract line 8 from 1 to find 9.
- Step 9 Withdraw mask and check that the line 9 cross totalling agrees.
- Step 10 Enter the final position figures in lines 4, 5, and 9 (i.e. in the "sign posts") into the box common to acquired and afforested and add to find items 10, 11 and 12.
- Step 11 Add items 10, 11 and 12 to find 13 which is inserted in "Tube".
- Step 12 Add 13 to entries higher in tube from Part 1 and so find Grand Forest Total (which should tally with column 22 of Part 1.)

Methods of Sharing Incentive Earnings. For Meth. Used --

1. P.W. Equal shares of Total Gang Earnings, in proportion to hours worked. Complete col. 8 (W1) first, then work out "W" for each man, using formula:- $\frac{W1}{H} \times h$

2. P.W. Grade Time Rates first ("t" cols.), then any P.W. balance (col. 9 i.e. W1 minus T) shared equally in proportion to hours worked, using $\frac{B1}{H} \times h$; enter in "b" cols. Add "t" & "b" for "W". $\frac{H}{H} \times h$

3. Bonus --- Col. 9 found direct, otherwise proceed as in 2. above.

4. P.W. Share of Total Gang Earnings (col. 8 i.e. W1) in proportion to Grade Time Rates. Complete "t" cols., total to find T, then work out "W" cols. using $\frac{W1}{T} \times t$.

5. P.W. Grade Time Rates first ("t" cols.), then share P.W. balance (B1), in proportion to Grade Time Rates, completing "b" cols. with $\frac{B1}{T} \times t$. Add cols. "t" & "b" for "W".

6. Bonus. Sim. to 5., only col. 9 i.e. B1 found direct.

Notes:- Methods 4 and 5 should similar results.

Ganger's Lead problem should first be resolved, esp. where P.W. is paid. If to be added separately, enter the "t" element as S.W. Rate.

If two Gangs or two Operations are being covered, repeat the Gang Number given (*) in approp. lines in the (1) and "H" cols.

Methods of Agreeing Incentive:-

(a) Straight Piece Work; use cols. 2, 6, & 8.

(b) Straight Bonus i.e. no Target; use cols. 2, 6, & 9.

(c) Bonus - payable only on Quanta achieved once a Target has been reached. Use cols. 2, 3, 6, & 9.

(d) Bonus - payable only on Quanta achieved beyond a Target, after it has been reached. Use cols. 2, 3, 6, 7 & 9.

(e) Straight Bonus (as in (b), up to a Target, then different rates as in (d) beyond. Take 2 lines in Ops. col. Use cols. as b & d resp.

(f) Bonus with Target as in "d", but adjustable to allow for broken Time. Can be applied to (d) & (e). Use cols. 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, & 9.
