This year the annual meeting of the B.A. will be held at Liverpool from 2nd to 9th September.

The Forestry Sub-section (K*) will meet under the Chairmanship of Mr A. P. Long, Director of Forestry for Wales.

The Chairman's address, on 4th September, will be entitled "The place of Forestry in Britain's Economy," and he will be followed by speakers on Private and Co-operative Forestry.

There will be a joint session on 8th September with Section K (Botany) on the Botany and Afforestation of Sand Dunes. Professor Thaarup will speak on Danish Dunes and Mr James Macdonald on British Dunes, and the film "The Culbin Story" will be shown by Mr Frank Oliver. The Freshfield dunes near Liverpool will be visited.

On 7th September there will be a session on Shelter Belts, with speakers on the Meteorological, Forestry and Farming aspects.

A symposium on the effects of smoke pollution on vegetation will take place on 9th September.

There will also be a paper on the timber production of private woodlands, and excursions to sawmills, factories, and the Duke of Westminster's Pulford estate, and Clocaenog and Delamere forests.
