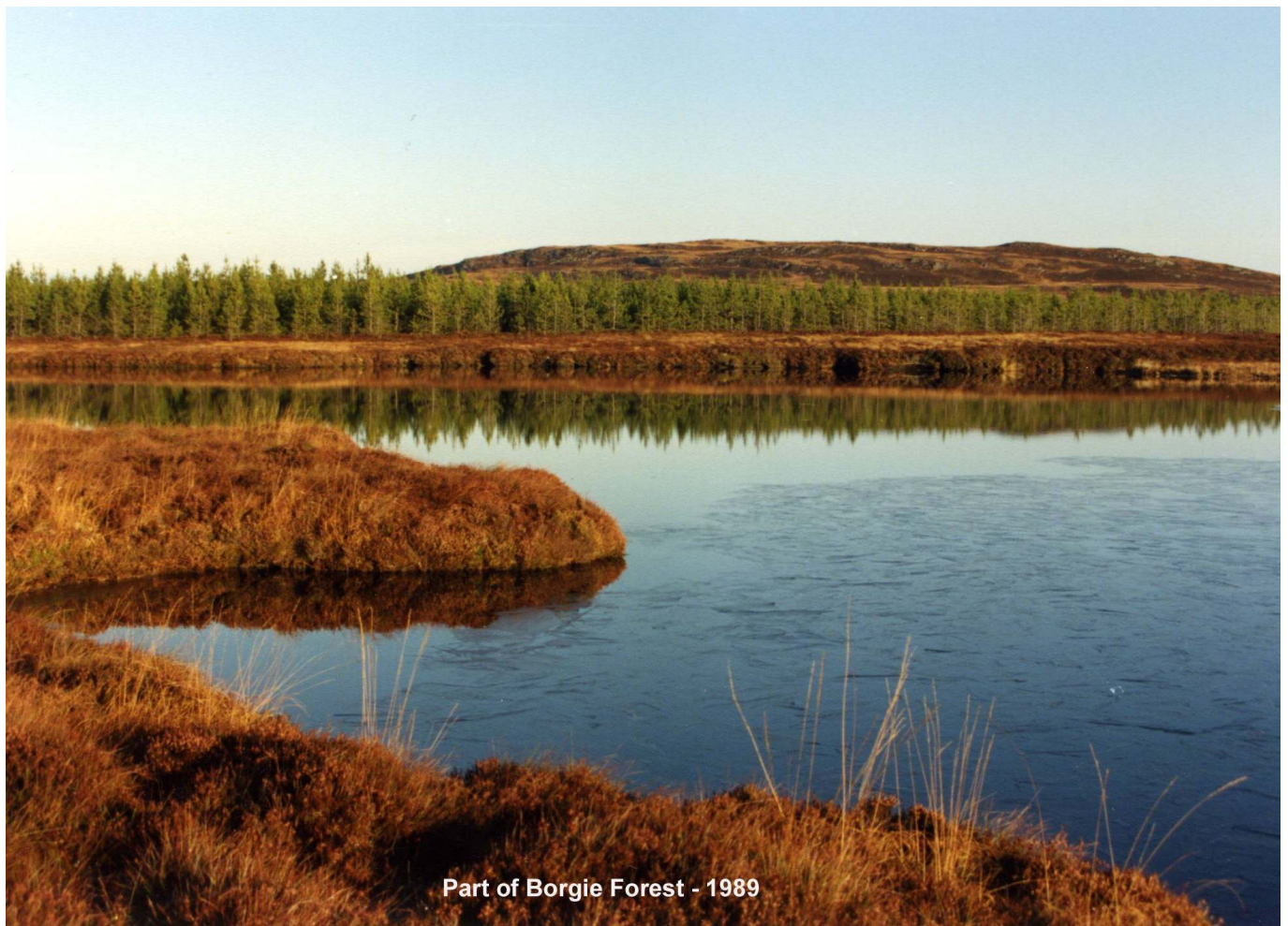




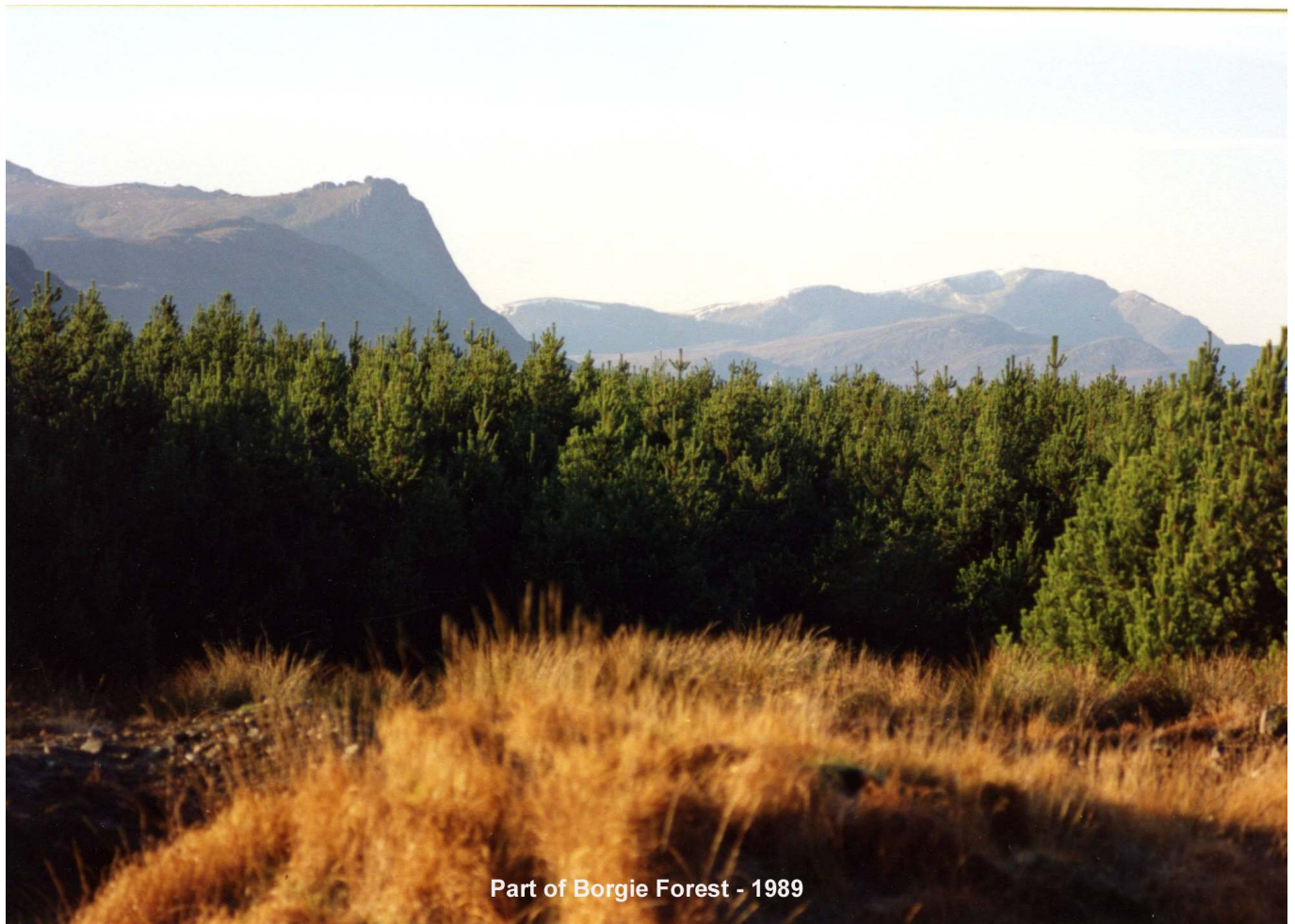

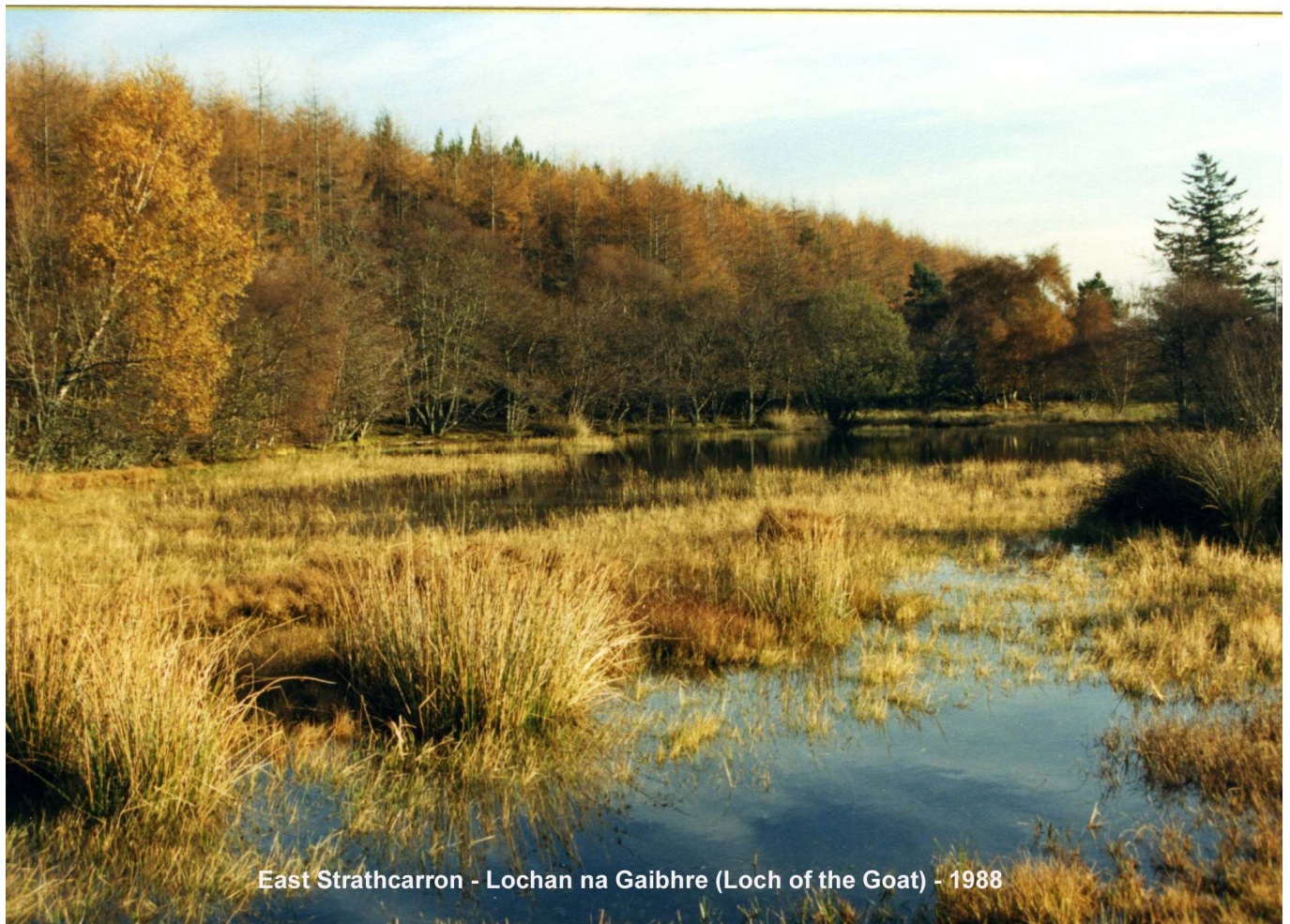

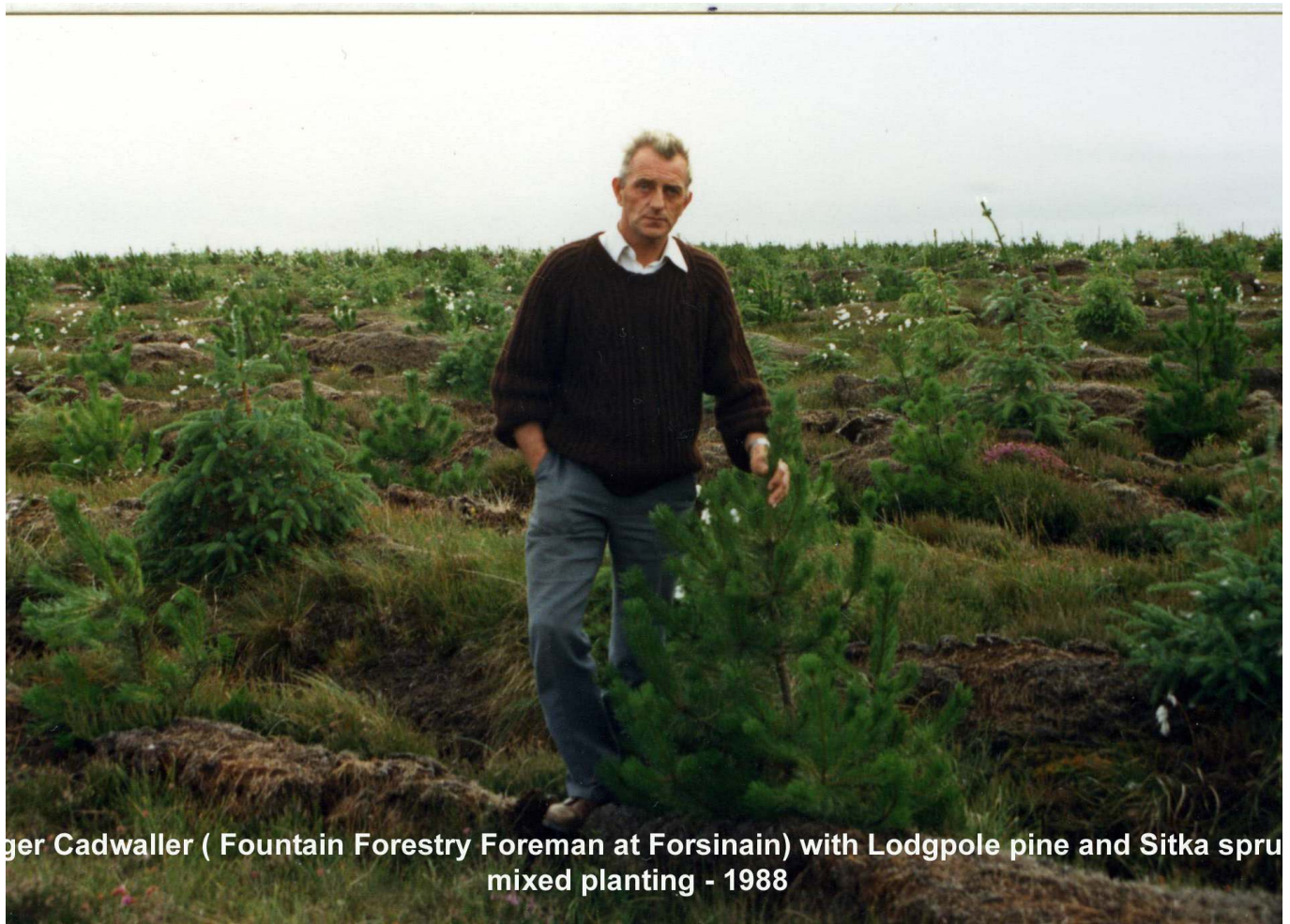

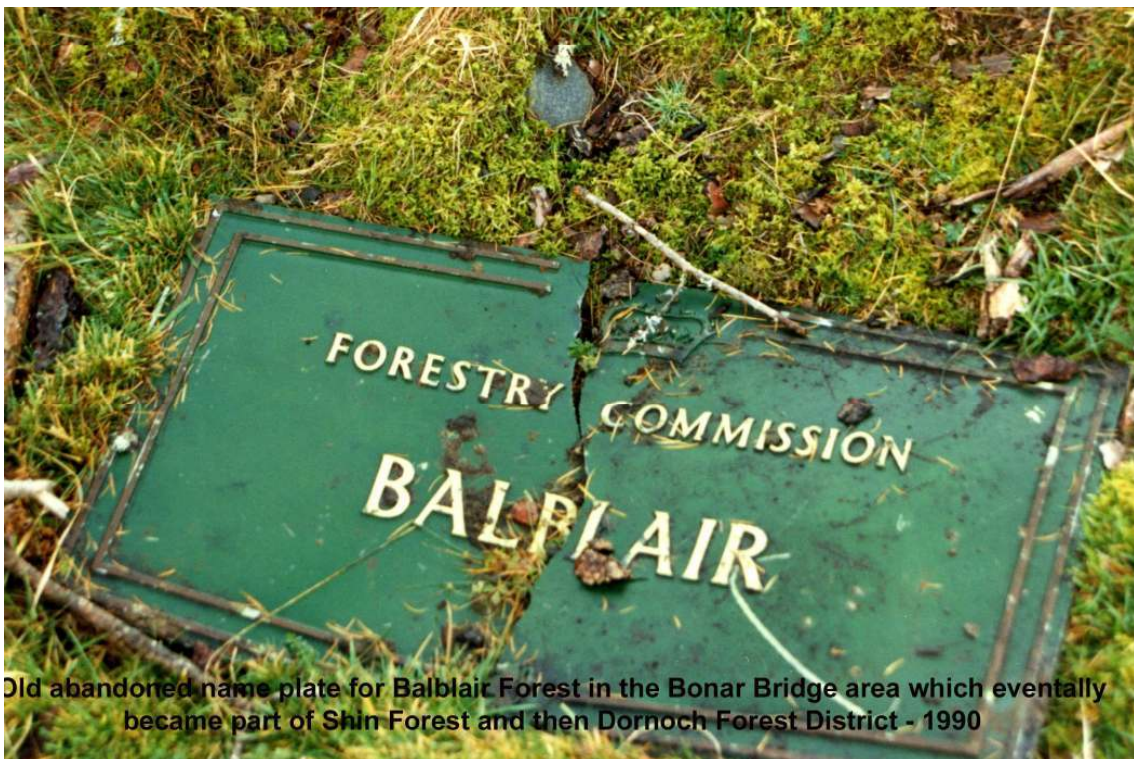
The Croick Old Parish Church well known for words written on its widows by evicted crofters and their families as they sheltered for a quite a long period within the church. 1990
