Fire Insurances.

We have received your letter of yesterday with your remarks on the list of omitted items we sent to you on 23rd inst., which we have noted and are communicating to the Insurance Company.

As regards the Plantation Insurances, we have to inform you that owing to their unfavourable experience with these risks during recent years the Insurance Offices have raised their rate to 10/6 per cent. The "Northern" was averse to this change, but has had to fall in with the other Tariff Companies. Please let us know if the raising of the rate will make any difference to the proposed revisal of your Plantation Insurances.
