- Heads with more than 6 points will be charged £5.57 per extra point.
- Heads with 5 or more points and 22 cm or over average antler length will be assessed by the CIC System - see framed section in table and 2 below.

2. Medal Scale

Heads with 5 or more points and 22 cm or over average antler length will be assessed by the CIC System and the following medal fees will be charged in addition to the Basic Scale:

Bronze: 105 CIC points: £132 plus £2.90 per CIC point or part point up to 114.9
 Silver: 115 CIC points: £174 plus £4.40 per CIC point or part point up to 129.9
 Gold: 130 CIC points: £305 plus £10.20 per CIC point or part point thereafter.

3. Freaks

Charges will be subject to local negotiation and agreement. (Large heads will be assessed by the CIC System).

Notes:

b. Beam is the minimum circumference between the brow and tray points. The charges asterisked will depend on beam as follows:-

9 cm and over - ¹²⁶/_{7*} £126; 8-9 cm - £100; under 8 cm - £73

c. £ x - charges will be subject to local negotiation and agreement.

2. Medal Scale

Medals will be awarded for heads gaining 8 points or more as follows:-

Gold: over 50 cm in length: (NA) beam

Silver: 40-49.9 cm in length: over 9 cm beam

Bronze: 40-49.9 cm in length 8-8.9 cm beam
